



Nativity Story Sensory Box

This sensory box is created using a combination of items you can probably find around your house or easily purchased.

This is intended to be a simple way to share the story of Jesus' birth with little ones using objects.

TIP: This resource is most effective if you decide ahead of time what you would like to share. Don't read from a page or follow a Script but have a conversation with your little ones, sharing the story. This might be something that you choose to build upon throughout the Advent season, perhaps adding more details or reading bible passages.

Mary: Object is a baby blanket to represent her being the mother of Jesus.

Joseph: Object is wood to represent that he was a carpenter.

Jesus: Object is a doll wrapped in a cloth.

Stuffed Donkey represents the journey Mary and Joseph took to Bethlehem, where Jesus was born.

Garland represents the angels that announced the birth of Jesus. You could also talk about the angels visiting both Mary and Joseph to tell them about the coming of Jesus.

Stuffed Sheep represents the shepherds who saw the angels and were the first to hear the news of his birth and the first to go visit him.

Star represents the star that appeared when Jesus was born. You could talk about the light it gave to lead the wisemen to find him.
